Faculty Recruitment Announcement

The Faculty of International Studies, Ryukoku University, is seeking to appoint one full-time, tenured faculty member as detailed below. We kindly request that this announcement be shared with individuals who may be interested or suitable candidates.

1. Major Field of Study: Global Ethics
2. Main Classes to be Taught: Global Studies C, Seminars, First-year subjects, etc.
It would be desirable to be able to teach either 'International Human Rights' or/and 'Global Governance'
3. Position and Rank: Associate Professor / Lecturer
(Department of Global Studies, Faculty of International Studies)
4. Starting Date of Employment: 1 April 2027
5. Required Qualifications :
 - (1) Doctoral degree or equivalent level of research attainments.
 - (2) Sufficient ability to perform assigned duties in Japanese.
 - (3) Understanding of the interdisciplinary characteristics of the Faculty/ Department, and the willingness and ability to actively contribute to the administrative tasks in the university and the faculty, such as entrance examinations and committees.
 - (4) Ability to teach and supervise graduate students.
 - (5) Professional proficiency of English
6. Required Documents :
 - (1) Academic Curriculum Vitae (adding a photo/entering your gender are optional) (one copy (Form 1))
 - (2) List of educational experience, qualifications and achievements (one copy (Form 2))
 - (3) List of research attainments (with the three most important marked with a circle) (one copy (Form 3))
 - (4) PDFs of the three publications marked in (3)
 - (5) Summaries of the three publications marked in (3), in English (approximately 250 words)
(one copy for each publication (Form 4))
 - (6) Highest academic degree and academic field / The names, affiliations and contacts of two persons who can provide references for the applicant (one copy (Form 5).)
 - (7) A statement of teaching philosophy once you are hired, on one sheet of A4 paper in any style/format (one copy)
 - * Please submit all required documents in the form of A4-size PDF.
 - * As a general rule, applicants are requested to use the designated forms and complete all documents using word processing software.

8. Document Submission Deadline: Must be received no later than Monday, 31 August 2026

9. Selection Process:

- (1) After screening the documents, short-listed candidates will be called for an interview and may also be asked to give a mock lecture to demonstrate teaching ability.
- (2) During the selection process, candidates may be asked to submit additional documentation including documents verifying the highest level of education completed.
- (3) The result of the selection process will be notified to applicants as soon as it is decided (scheduled for November, 2026).

10. Others:

- (1) Ryukoku University respects diversity among its faculty. In order to ensure diversity in education, research, and social contribution. When there are multiple candidates who demonstrate excellent abilities for a position, hiring decision will be made with full consideration for diversity. As of April 2026, 36% of academic staff in the Faculty of International Studies hold foreign nationality or are of foreign origin, and 35% are women.
