The center is open. Online and face-to-face interviews will be conducted by advance application. Individual boxes are available by advance reservation system for online selection purposes. Finally, usage of the Free Space is limited to 60 minutes. · < Career Center Events > are, in principle, held online, but events with a small number of people may be held in a face-to-face format. · < Handling of Guests > Companies will be limited to three per day to avoid overlapping of time. · Employment Services at <Osaka Umeda Campus> and <Tokyo Office> will be held according to the circumstances of each.
Level 1	No Entry Restrictions	In principle face-to-face lessons are held, but some large group lessons that cannot secure social distance in classrooms will be conducted in an online format. ※Student activities (excluding extracurricular activities) shall be carried out after taking sufficient infection prevention measures in accordance with the activity restriction level response to extracurricular activities.
